It will be open from 3.25 - 3.45 – parents can wait beside the Year 5 entrance (near the portacabin) where they will be let in by the teacher.

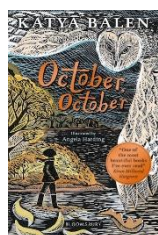

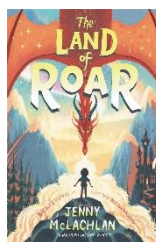
