If you are arriving by car, please be aware that parking on the school site is limited. There is street parking opposite the school but please do not park in the bus bays or cycle lanes or block any of our neighbours' driveways. There is overspill parking at the nearby Hopwood Hall College Middleton Campus (main car park).

If you want to try out our public transport links and leave the car at home, the 17 service runs regularly between Manchester Shudehill and Rochdale bus stations via Middleton and stops directly outside of the school, as does the 434 service which runs between Middleton and Rochdale via Boarshaw.
